## GENERAL SHOW RULES:

- Arrival time:** begins 12:00 pm Friday May 21, 2021. Registration check in will be 1-8 pm Friday, 6:30-7:30 am Saturday and 6:30-7:30 am Sunday.
- Schedule:** Showmanship will begin 5 pm Friday followed by the Youth Show. Buck show Ring 1 will begin 6 pm Friday. Saturday Sr doe ring 1 will begin 8 am and Ring 2 will begin 8:30 am. The Jr doe shows will follow the conclusion of the Sr doe shows. Saturday evening Buck shows will follow the conclusion of the Jr doe shows. Sunday Sr doe show ring 3 will begin 8 am and Sr doe show ring 4 will begin at 8:30 am

immediately followed by ring 3 and 4 Jr doe shows.

3. **Health Check:** Goats may be examined on the grounds by the PDGA Health Check committee, veterinarians and/or state/federal personnel upon entry or at any time during the show. Goats showing evidence of infectious diseases WILL NOT be allowed to enter or remain in the barn or show and may be released. Out of State goats must have a valid Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI). **PDGA HEALTH CHECK COMMITTEE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
4. No dogs are allowed in the barn or show ring area.
5. No smoking or vaping in the barns.
6. **Piedmont Dairy Goat Association will not be held liable for any loss, injury or accidents incurred before, during or after the show to animals, persons, or personal property.**
7. **Entries:** These shows are sanctioned by the American Dairy Goat Association. There will be 4 SR Doe Rings, 4 JR Doe Rings, 1 combined sanction Youth show, and 3 combined sanction Buck Rings. JR and SR Doe Rings are separately sanctioned. Goats must be registered, recorded, or applied for with ADGA, AGS, or CGS.
8. Entry fee is \$7.00 per goat per ring, unless the goat is entered in all 4 rings (3 rings if a buck), then it is \$6.00 per ring.
9. **Entries after 5/11/21 DOUBLE (\$14.00/goat per ring). ENTRIES ON 5/21/21 ARE \$20 EACH. No entries allowed after 8:00 pm 5/21/21**
10. **If the show is cancelled due to COVID-19 we will refund any fees paid.**
11. Pens are 5x5 and are \$5 each. Bedding can be preordered at \$6/bag. We will be assigning pens and providing as much space as possible between tack pens in order to allow for social distancing. Exhibitors will be allowed to show out of trailers if they choose to not pay for pens. If you have bucks who are difficult to secure in pens, please consider stalling them in your trailer.
12. No charge for youth show entries or showmanship. Youth show entries must be owned by the youth (on the registration papers) or co-owned by farm, group or family. *Showmanship entries DO NOT need to own the doe.* Youth age is under 21 on day of show.
13. All open show entries must be in the name of the actual owner as shown on the Registration Papers or on the Stamped Duplicates. **Entry forms must be completed and payment must be made in full before an animal will be allowed to show.** Online entries may be paid through PayPal. Checks are accepted with mail in entries but not day of show. **There will be no refund for entries scratched unless COVID related.** Substitutions are allowed through registration and check in. **LAST MINUTE RINGSIDE SUBSTITUTIONS ARE NOT ALLOWED.**
14. The original registration certificate or stamped duplicate applications, showing the date received by the ADGA office (within the last 30 days) is required for all goats under six months of age as well as for Guernseys. Papers must be shown at check in.
15. **No tattooing** allowed at the show.
16. **No pre show milk out.** Overruddered does may be discriminated against by the judges. Please see to the comfort of your does and dispose of milk in a bio-secure manner.
17. Exhibitors are requested to be neatly and appropriately attired in **show whites** while showing. Only exhibitors, judges, and those working the show are to be in the ring or at the show secretary tables. Shirts, and shoes must be worn at all times while in the barns and show rings.
18. If you are showing multiple breeds, please bring additional help or allow others to show your goats so the show can continue to run smoothly with minimal interruption. **The show will not be held up to wait for exhibitors that are showing in the other ring.**

19. **COVID policy:** At the writing of these show rules we have no way of knowing the future state of the pandemic. Any of these rules might be modified closer to the date of our show. In an attempt to conservatively plan at this time we are putting forward this COVID protocol:

- If you are feeling unwell or exhibit any COVID symptoms before the show, we ask that you exercise all caution and **PLEASE STAY HOME**. Contact the show chair to update us and to receive a refund of entry fees.
- **We require that all exhibitors and spectators wear appropriate masks worn correctly while in the ring or at ringside. No exceptions. Masks and mask wearing must follow current CDC guidelines as interpreted by the show committee.** If you choose to not wear a mask correctly, you will be excused from the ring, your animal will not be judged and your entry fees forfeit.
- We request that all efforts be made to maintain social distancing while

in the show ring, entering the ring, waiting ringside, and throughout the barn. Ring stewards will aid judges in guiding exhibitors toward appropriate spacing in the ring.

- We request no chairs or standing at ring entrances to allow for the flow of exhibitors and goats. Please use the bleachers ringside to watch the show and maintain social distance from those not in your immediate party.
- Showmanship classes will not be required to switch goats between exhibitors.
- As a show committee we are committed to helping maintain COVID safety any way we can. Masks will be made available for those who need them and hand sanitizer will be available ringside and throughout the barn.

20. Any situation arising not covered by these rules will be decided by the show committee. Show officials have the responsibility for enforcing rules, maintaining standards and solving problems that may arise during this event.

**THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE.** Order of breeds shown will be determined and announced once we are closer to show date and can establish the best flow with numbers of each breed entered. Show breed order will be posted in each ring. Breeds will remain in the ring they are shown and judges with their show secretaries will travel between rings. For those new to this we will explain before the start of the first ring.

Each Grand, Reserve, and Best of Breed must remain in the ring for the judge to read tattoos and their registration papers must be presented to the show secretary at that time. **Exhibitors are cautioned to verify the accuracy on the show report before signing the Report of Awards.**

**Senior Doe** shows will be sanctioned for **Alpine, Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, Saanen and Toggenburg and AOP (Sable and Guernsey).**

**Junior Doe** shows will be sanctioned for **Alpine, LaMancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Oberhasli, Recorded Grade, and AOP (Saanen, Toggenburg, Sable, and Guernsey).**

**Youth Doe** show will be sanctioned for **Alpine, Nigerian Dwarf, Recorded Grade and AOP (LaMancha, Nubian, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, Sable, and Guernsey).**

**Bucks** will be sanctioned for **Lamancha, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, and AOP (Alpine, Oberhasli, Saanen, Toggenburg, Sable, and Guernsey).**

**Base date for computing age will be May 21,2021.**
